



IDI[®] QUALIFYING SEMINAR TUITION PRICING STRUCTURE

Listed below is the current Qualifying Seminar tuition pricing structure for registrants to attend the IDI Qualifying Seminar. Please note how each rate applies so that you know you are paying the correct price.

TUITION RATES

\$2,000 USD

This is the standard tuition rate when registering.

\$1,800 USD (Not-for-profit – Discounted Rate)

This discounted rate applies if you (as a registrant) fall into one of the following categories:

- You work full-time for a Non-Profit organization
- You work full-time for a department of a Government entity

\$1,600 USD (Educational Institution – Discounted Rate)

This discounted rate applies if you (as a registrant) fall into one of the following categories:

- You are a full-time faculty member at a college/university or K-12 school
- You are a full-time staff member at a college/university or K-12 school
- You are a full-time student at a college/university

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

***Q** I am an independent consultant full-time, but I work as an adjunct professor. Which rate should I pay?*

***A** As an independent consultant not working **full-time** for the university, you would pay the standard tuition price of \$2,000 as the Educational Institution discounted rate is reserved for full-time staff and faculty members only.*

***Q** I volunteer at a non-profit organization. Am I eligible for the Not-for-profit discounted tuition?*

***A** The Not-for-profit discounted tuition rate is reserved for **full-time employees** of Non-Profit organizations and Government agencies only.*
